

Website and Cookies Notice

Cookies on our websites

Cookies are small text files that are automatically placed onto your device by some websites that you visit. They are widely used to allow a website to function (for example to keep track of your basket) as well to provide website operators with information on how the site is being used.

When you access our websites, some cookies are saved to your computer, for example if you have chosen a particular language setting or created a user account. You can also turn off your cookies so that we can't access that information.

How do we use this information?

Here at Pallant House Gallery, we use cookies to collect anonymous data on how visitors use our website. We don't store any information that would identify you personally in the cookies we create, but we do look at trends and patterns to try to improve your experience of using our website.

Cookies that we use

Here are a list of the cookies that we use and what we use them for. In common with many sites, we classify them as 'performance'. This means they are used to enhance site performance. These cookies don't collect information that identify a user. All information that these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. Persistent cookies will remain for a certain number of days or months.

Cookie name	What it's used for	Type of cookies	Expires
__utms, __utma, __utmb, __utmc, __utmt	These cookies are set by Google Analytics to allow us to monitor traffic	performance – collects anonymous information on pages visited	persistent – 182 days

Accepting or blocking cookies

You don't have to do anything to accept cookies set by Pallant House Gallery: by continuing to use this site you are giving your consent to receive them. If you do want to block cookies, you need to do this by changing the settings in your browser to reject them from this site.

We don't share any personal data that you supply, although we may share information about general user trends with our partners and donors. We don't track user behaviour after you have left our site.
